WHAT IS THE DELIVERABLE FUELS PROGRAM?

The Deliverable Fuels Program provides energy for low-income households at their primary residence when their primary heating source is a deliverable fuel.

Deliverable fuels are non-metered resources such as:

- Propane
- Fuel oil
- Pellets
- Firewood



HOW DO I APPLY?

Apply for State Emergency Relief (SER) through MDHHS and bring Northwest Michigan Community Action Agency your approval letter. MDHHS determines your eligibility and Northwest Michigan Community Action Agency will assist with the rest of the process of receiving the deliverable fuels. Must apply by September 30.

WHAT ARE THE GUIDELINES?*

- Northwest Michigan Community Action Agency can assist with residents in the following counties: Grand Traverse, Benzie, Antrim, Leelanau, Wexford, Roscommon, Charlevoix, Emmett, Missaukee and Kalkaska counties.
- Must be a deliverable fuel that is not meter read by a company.
- Approved State Emergency Relief (SER) letter from Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.
